Current Priorities

Our Vision was approved in June 2015. In April 2016 the following Priorities were agreed by the Circuit Council:

Five building blocks to create a culture for Growing in Christ

- Re-imagined governance
- Strong small groups
- Effective leadership

To allow us to:

- Release missionary congregations
- Grow a range of diverse ministries

Re-imagined governance: A Resources Manager has been employed to help churches deal with governance and property issues and to find ways of freeing people for other ministries.

Strong small groups: Building on the strengths of the old Methodist Class system, growing strong groups that care for members, help them grow and nurture their gifts. Lent and Bible Month groups are being promoted across the Circuit and training for group leaders is being arranged.

Effective leadership: Provide a framework for equipping lay leaders, including training and mentoring, and supporting risk-taking.

Release missionary congregations and Grow a range of diverse ministries: To enhance existing congregations’ worship and prayer, engage with local communities and inspire new congregations. With a partnership of ordained and lay leadership, responding to needs and opportunities as they arise and providing a framework for support.
